

## "We believe the Bible to be the inspired and only infallible written Word of God."

## THE above phrase is the first line in the Statement of Faith for many Christian Churches. Today, this statement's validity is under attack.

- There are 50+ Non-KJV English Bible Versions on BibleGateway.com (Oct 2016).
- When the contents of these versions are compared —specifically a comparison of select passages with the corresponding passages in the King James Bible (KJV)
   —the reader discovers that the meaning of passages between the versions differ and the foundation of Christian doctrine has been altered from that in the KJV.
- Non-KJV Bible Versions contain some passages that add to or take away from those written in the KJV. Sometimes this is done by brackets and/or footnote explanations that question whether the passages are truly God's Word. Some passages reflect doctrinal error. For God's Word to be "inspired" and "infallible" there cannot be multiple meanings and multiple doctrines in multiple Bibles.
